### **BARCELONA AIRPORT TO HOTEL CATALONIA-CASTELLNOU**

#### **Barcelona Airport Taxis Tel: (0034) 93 303 3033**

Travelling by Taxi is a convenient way to get from the airport to the city centre. You'll find the airport Barcelona taxi rank on the left hand side when you leave the airport main exit. The taxis operate all night and there are several hundred of them so you don't have to worry about not being able to catch a cab.

The journey to the city centre will take you between 20 to 30 mins depending on road conditions.

Expect to pay around 25 Euros for the journey into the centre. There will also be an additional surcharge charge for each bag you're carrying. You'll find the rates displayed inside the cab.

All official Barcelona taxis are black and yellow and are required to charge you only the value on the meter (Plus any surcharge. Surcharges include a supplement for travelling from the Airport, or to or from the port and also for each suitcase, all surcharge rates are displayed in the back of the taxi). The taxi service in Barcelona is generally very good, clean and reliable.

#### **Aerobus - Airport Express bus service to Barcelona city centre Tel: (0034) 93 415 6020**

The Aerobus service is a shuttle bus service that links Barcelona airport to the city centre. This service normally runs every 15 mins within its fixed hours of operation. You can catch the Aerobus from the airport and it stops at all 3 terminals. Ticket Price is 3.90 euros for a single and 6.70 Euros for a round trip. Tickets can only be purchased on the bus. Save 20% on the ticket price with the Barcelona Card

The Aerobus will then take you to the city centre where you can:

- alight at Placa Espana and take a taxi to the hotel; or
- carry on and alight at Placa de Catalunya where you can take the subway called 'Ferrocarrils de la Generalitat' either line S5 or L6. Both lines start there, so there will be only one direction to go to and whatever of the two you take, you should leave at the station: Les "TRES TORRES", this would be 6 stops. From Tres Torres station, the Hotel Castellnou is at no more than 5 minutes walk.

You can see the hotel and where the subway station is on the triangle between "Via Augusta", Carrer del Rosari and Carrer del Doctor Foix, next to the red shading on the Map.

So you only have to go down Carrer del Rosari and the third right to Carrer Castellnou.
